

<u>Bulk Uplift - 4 November 2020</u>

Due to the Co-operative not being able to provide skips for our tenants we have agreed to trial a company, Cameron Cleaning to go round our estates and uplift and dispose of bulk household items.

To do this we require all residents in flatted accommodation to leave bulk items at the side of their communal bin store area; those in back and front doors must leave them at the front of the property

(on pavement) and Law View if bulk items can be placed inside your front gate.

Should you have any large items to be uplifted you must place them in these areas by 8am on the date of uplift – 4 November 2020

There are exemptions to what can be uplifted and this will include :-

garden rubble, asbestos, car parts, gas bottles and any other hazardous or special waste.

Only HOUSEHOLD items will be uplifted but will not include fridges and fridge freezers.

All items is required to be left tidy, bagged or tied up i.e. laminate flooring to be tied up and carpets rolled up.

This service is ONLY available to our tenants on a trial basis.

If the Co-operative finds the service is overused resulting in the costs exceeding the budget then we will have no alternative but to review it. This could ultimately result in the withdrawal of both uplift service and the skips.
